

SCRIPTURE MEMORY VERSES:

1. Romans 8:12-14 "So, dear brothers and sisters you have no obligation whatsoever to do what your sinful nature urges you to do. For if you keep on following it, you will perish. But if through the power of the Holy Spirit you turn from it and its evil deeds, you will live. For all who are led by the Spirit of God are children of God."

2. Romans 12:2 Don't copy the behavior and customs of this world, **but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think.** Then you will know what God wants you to do and you will know how good and pleasing and perfect His will really is."

3. 1 Peter 2:21-23 This suffering is all part of what God has called you to. Christ, who suffered for you, is your example. Follow in His steps. He never sinned, and He never deceived anyone. He did not retaliate when He was insulted. When He suffered, He did not threaten to get even. He left His case in the hands of God, who always judges fairly.

4. Romans 8:5-7:11 Those who are dominated by the sinful nature think about sinful things, but those who are controlled by the Holy Spirit think about things that please the Spirit. If your sinful nature controls your mind, there is death. But if the Holy Spirit controls your mind, there is life and peace. For the sinful nature is always hostile to God. It never did obey God's laws, and it never will. The Spirit of God, who raised Jesus from the dead, lives in you!"

5. 2 Peter 1:3 "His divine **power** has given us everything we need for life and godliness through our knowledge of Him who called us by His own glory and goodness."

6. Genesis 4:7 Sin is crouching at the door and its desire is for you, but you must master it.

7. Psalm 81:13-14 "But OH that My people would listen to Me. Oh that they would follow Me, walking in My paths! How quickly I would then subdue their enemies! How soon My hands would be upon their foes."

8. 1 Peter 4:12-13 12Dear friends don't be surprised at the **fiery trials** you are going through, as if something strange were happening to you. Instead, be very glad--because these trials will make you partners with Christ in His suffering..."

9. Song of Solomon 2:15 "Quick! Catch all the little foxes before they ruin the vineyard of your love, for the grapevines are all in blossom."

10. Lamentations 3:37 "Can anything happen without the Lord's permission?"

11. Deuteronomy 33:26 "There is no one like the God of Israel. He rides across the heavens to help you, across the skies in majestic splendor."

12. Isaiah 1:18 "**Come** now, and **let us reason** together, "Says the Lord..."

13. Isaiah 7:9 "...You do not believe Me? If you want Me to protect you, learn to believe what I say."

14. Psalm 27:8 "My heart has heard You say, "Come and talk with Me" and my heart responds, "Lord, I am coming"

15. Zechariah 11:11 "...they were watching me and they knew that the Lord was speaking to them through my actions."

16. 1 Peter 4:1 "Those who are willing to suffer for Christ have DECIDED to stop sinning"

17. John 10:27 "My sheep hear My voice and I know them and they follow Me."

18. Isaiah 30:21 "Whether you turn to the right or the left, your ears will hear a voice behind you saying, "This is the way, walk in it."

19. 1 Kings 18:21 "...How long will you hesitate between two opinions? If the Lord is God, follow Him; but if Baal follow him..."

20. Galatians 5:1 So Christ has really set us free. Now make sure that you stay free, and don't get tied up again in slavery to the law.

21. Hebrews 4:12-16 12For the word of God is full of living power. It is sharper than the sharpest knife, cutting deep into our innermost thoughts and desires. It exposes us for what we really are. Nothing in all creation can hide from Him.

Everything is naked and exposed before His eyes. This is the God to whom we must explain all that we have done. That is why we have a great High Priest who has gone to heaven, Jesus the Son of God. Let us cling to Him and never stop trusting Him. This High Priest of ours understands our weaknesses, for He faced all of the same temptations we do, yet He did not sin. So let us come boldly to the throne of our gracious God. There we will receive His mercy, and we will find grace to help us when we need it.

22. John 3:30 He must become greater and greater, and I must become less and less. ("He must increase, I must decrease" NASB)

23. 1 John 5:4 For every child of God defeats this evil world by trusting Christ to give the victory.

24. Proverbs 30:5 "Every Word of God proves true. He defends all who come to Him for protection."

25. Genesis 50:20 "But as for you, you intended evil against me but God intended it for good to bring about this present result, the saving of many lives."

26. Psalm 51:6 "God desires Truth in the innermost being and in the hidden part You will make me know wisdom

27. Philippians 2:13 "For God is working in you, giving you the desire to obey him and the power to do what pleases him."

28. Proverbs 4:20-22 "Pay attention My child to what I say. Listen carefully. Don't lose sight of My words. Let them penetrate deep within your heart, (your mind) for they bring life and radiant health to anyone who discovers their meaning."

29. Psalm 77:1 "I cry out to God without holding back..."

30. 1 John 1:9 "If we confess our sins God is faithful and righteous to forgive our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."

31. 1 Corinthians 10:13 "No temptation has overtaken you but such as is common to man and God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will provide the way of escape also, so that you will be able to endure it.

32. 2 Corinthians 10:3-5 NASB "... we are taking every thought captive to the obedience of Christ." "We are human, but we don't wage war with human plans and methods. We use God's mighty weapons, not mere worldly weapons, to knock down the devil's strongholds." NLT

33. Philippians 4:6-7 Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all comprehension, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

34. Philippians 4:8-9 Finally, brethren, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is of good repute, if there is any excellence and if anything worthy of praise, dwell on these things. The things you have learned and received and heard and seen in me, practice these things, and the God of peace will be with you.
